Project Plant Update



Tips and Techniques

Have you ever been watering your plants with your favourite water can and spilled water on the leaves? These water drops can mark your plants and leave fertilizer or mineral deposits on the leaves that is sometimes difficult to clean off. The damage can be permanent if not attended to immediately.

I use a small natural sea sponge, which you can sometimes find at the cosmetic counter. I soak it in warm water and squeeze it out so that it is damp but not wet. If I happen to spill a bit of water on my leaves as I'm tending to them, I gently touch the sponge to the droplets and the sponge sucks up the water and I have fixed the problem immediately instead of trying to remember to come back later or forgetting altogether. Make this a common practice when you water and you'll have spot free plants.
